WHAT DOES TMG FINANCIAL SERVICES, ISSUER OF ATIRACredit MASTERCARD DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- account balances and payment history
- credit history and credit score

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the sections below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reason TMG Financial Services chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

If you are a *new* customer, we can begin sharing your information 30 days from the date we sent this notice. When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described.

What we do**How does TMG Financial Services protect my personal information?**

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does TMG Financial Services collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you:

- open an account or pay your bills
- give us your income information or provide your mortgage information
- use your credit card.

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only:

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. [See below for more on your rights under state law.]

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions**Affiliates**

Our affiliates include companies with a common corporate identity of TMG Financial Services.

Nonaffiliates

Nonaffiliates we share with can include companies that perform support or marketing services on our behalf, such as mailing, market research and data processing; insurance companies and retailers.

Joint marketing companies

Our joint marketing partners include companies that are our partners for co-branded credit card programs or reward programs, or insurance companies and retailers.

Other important information

The information-sharing practices described above are in accordance with Federal law. You may have other privacy protections under state laws. We will comply to the extent applicable.

For Vermont Residents

In accordance with Vermont law, TMGFS will not share information we collect about Vermont residents to nonaffiliated third-party companies except:

- With the authorization or consent of the Vermont resident;
- To companies that perform marketing or other services on our behalf;
- Name, contact and transaction and experience information (such as your account balance and payment history) to other financial institutions with which we have joint marketing agreements; or
- As permitted by law.

For California Residents

To the extent required by California law, TMGFS will not share information we collect about California residents with companies outside of the TMGFS affiliate companies except:

- With the authorization or consent of the California resident;
- To service the member's accounts;
- To fulfill on rewards or benefits; or
- As permitted by law.

For Nevada Residents

Cardmembers who are residents of Nevada are being provided this notice under Nevada state law.
